The Eller African American Honorary is dedicated to advancing the African American community at the University of Arizona. The organization primarily serves



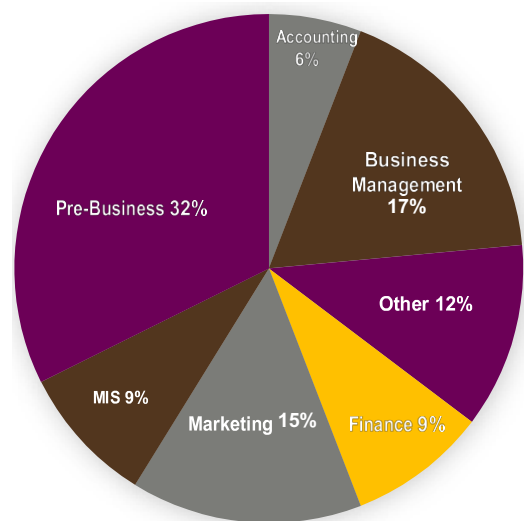
students within the Eller College of Management. We are advocates for African American students at the University of Arizona and within the Greater Tucson area. We have grown our community through
